Central Wisconsin Sporting Spaniel Club (CWSSC) will host a Fall Field Trial , Mid-Week, Thursday October 26 and Friday October 27, 2017 in New Glarus, WI on the Oasis Game Farm property N9074 Cty Rd J, New Glarus, WI.

The OPEN all-age stake will begin on Thursday October 26 at 8:00 am and run until conclusion and the AMATEUR All-age Stake will start no earlier than 8:00 am on Friday October 27 and run until conclusion. The PUPPY Stake will start after the 2nd series of the Open Stake on Thursday October 26 but not before noon. Pheasants will be used for both All-Age Stakes and chukars will be used for the Puppy Stake.

The WATER TEST is available to only dogs that are entered in the trial AND if they need the WATER TEST to COMPLETE their title are eligible to be run.

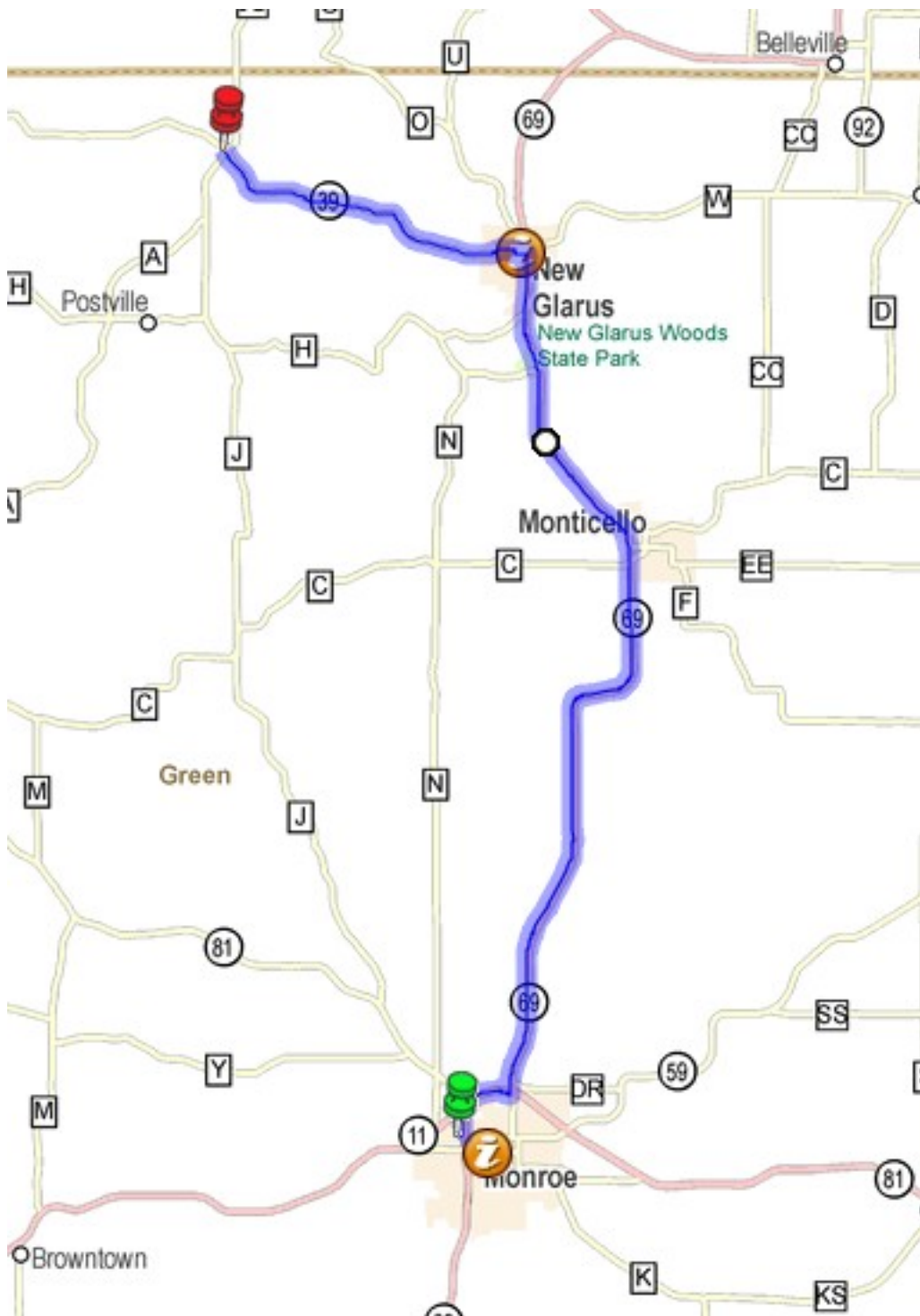
