Directions to Pine Shadows Daybreak

Coming into Aberdeen from the East:

Going west on Highway 12 all the way through Aberdeen. Turn north on highway 281 at the western edge of Aberdeen.

Go North to Brown County highway 10. Turn left (West) and go four miles to Brown County 6. Turn north and go 4 miles to 111th Street, Turn left and go one mile. You have arrived!

Coming from the north

From Ellendale North Dakota head south on highway 281 until Brown County 5 in Frederick, Turn west and go four miles on Brown Cty. 5 then turn south on county road 6 and go four miles then turn west on 111th street and go one mile.

Coming into Aberdeen from the West:

Going west on Highway 12 turn north on highway 281 at the western edge of Aberdeen. Go North to Brown County highway 10. Turn left (West) and go four miles to Brown County 6. Turn north and go 4 miles to 111th Street, Turn left and go one mile. You have arrived!
