CLEAN UP DOG

A "cleanup dog(s)" will be made available after each day's stake in an effort to retrieve all shot and crippled birds. Unshot birds will NOT be hunted after the trial. Anyone interested in having a dog work as a "clean up dog", provided that it is NOT a dog running in the trial, can contact the field trial Chairman or Secretary before the start of the trial.

EVENT EMERGENCY AND VETERINARIAN INFORMATION

In accordance with an "Amendment in the Standard Procedures for Spaniel Field Trials" effective September 1, 1994 a blaze orange garment or item of clothing is mandatory at all AKC licensed and sanctioned field trials for ALL persons in the gallery and in the field.

NO ATV's will be allowed on the field except those used by the committee for bird planters or movement of judges. Request to use personal ATV's must be made to the chairman prior to entering the field. ALL ATV'S MUST HAVE AN ORANGE FLAG which can be seen by the gunners in the field.

Consistent with AKC regulations, the use of prong collars is prohibited on the trial grounds. This regulation will be strictly enforced.

Sever training, correcting or disciplining of dogs will not be allowed on any part of the grounds.

SCRATCHES

Scratches prior to closing date will be refunded by HuntSecretary.com unless Club Scratch Policy below states otherwise.

After the closing date, all scratches will be handled based on the Club Scratch Policy specified below.

Club Scratch Policy

ESSCLI FIELD TRIAL REFUND POLICY

Entry fees will be refunded in full for a bitch withdrawn because of coming in season, or for a dog withdrawn because of injury or illness, or for a dog that has died prior to closing date. (A veterinary certificate is required for all health-related refunds)

HOT WEATHER PROVISION:

1- The recorded high estimated temperature of the day at the publish start time of the trial as listed in the premium is 80 degrees F or above or the "Real Feel" is 80 degrees F or above using the Accuweather system (CANISTEO, NY) for reporting temperature.

2 - The handler is present at the trial in sufficient time in advance of the published start time of the stake entered at the trial so they can observe the cover, layout of the course, provisions made by the club such as cooling tanks and locations, additional sources of water, review the clubs (EAP) Emergency Action Plan and other factors such as possible safety instructions announcements by the committee to the guns, marshals and judges so they as a handler can determine if they believe they would not like to run their dog(s) under the conditions of the day as made acceptable under this provision.

3 - The handler asks the field trial Secretary or field trial Chairman for a refund BEFORE the 1st dog of Open All Age stake or the Amateur All Age stake or Puppy stake at the trial has been cast off the line.

4- Refunds will be issued at the day of the trial at a moment that will not interfere with the operation of the trial. Amount refunded will be less current AKC recording fees and Huntsecretary.com entry fees charged to the club.
