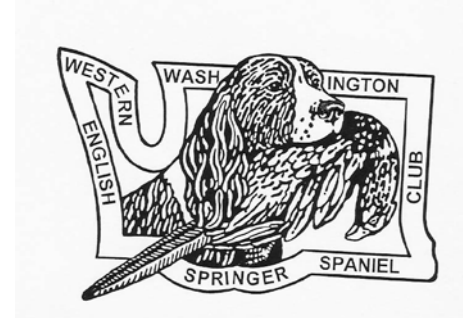

Water Certification Test

We have tentatively scheduled an AKC Water Certification test for Saturday April 21, following the judging of the Open All-Age stake. The test will take place at the Scatter Creek WDFW in Rochester, WA. Cost per dog will be \$20, payable on the day of the test.

STANDARD PROCEDURE FOR SPANIEL FIELD TRIALS

13a. Before an English Springer Spaniel shall receive its Field or Amateur Field Championship or National Open or Amateur Championship title, it must have shown its ability to retrieve game from water, after a swim. The water test shall consist of two back-to-back, open water, 30-40 yard retrieves of dead ducks or dead pheasants, with gunshot. The dog is to be backed up to 10 to 15 yards from the bank for its entry.

Bitches in season shall not be eligible for competition in any stake and shall not be allowed on the field trial grounds. The entry fee for bitches that come into season after entries close will be refunded.
