Dear Field Trialers:

The Rocky Mountain Springer Spaniel Association cordially invites you to our annual fall field trial. This year we are holding our trial on Sunday, March 8 and Monday, March 9, in conjunction with the Northern Colorado Springer Spaniel Club on the same weekend. The trial grounds are located north of WCR 14 and east of WCR 37 on the Miller property. The cover is a mixture of grass and weeds.

Our All Age judges are Bob Bullard and Darrel Roth. The Open Stake will start no sooner than the conclusion of the Northern Colorado Springer Spaniel Club Trial on Sunday March 8. The Amateur Stake will start after the first session of the Open and they will alternate until concluded. The Puppy Stake will run concurrently with the alternating all-age series. We will not have a formal training session before the trial. Our Puppy judges will be

announced before the trial.

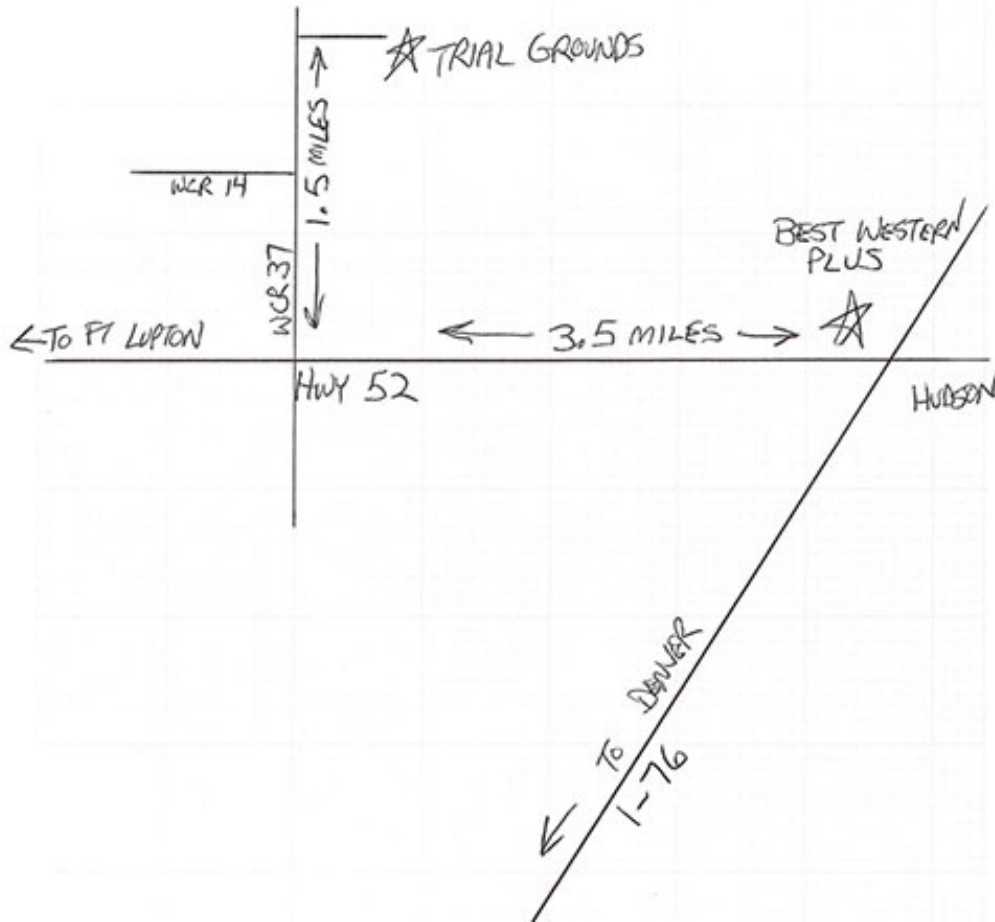
