**Entry Fees:** **Open All Age - \$135.00** per dog per day; **Puppy Stake- \$30.00 per Day.** Listing fee for dogs not registered with the C.K.C. is **\$10.50** per day unless an ERN has been applied for. *No dog will be allowed to compete unless fees have been paid.*

**Listing Fee:** A listing fee as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form.

**Event Registration Number:** All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned require an event registration number (ERN) to enable them to be awarded titles by the CKC. Dogs may be entered as "listed"; however, an ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. Application forms may be obtained from the Field Trial Secretary.

**Non-Member Participation Fee**

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members".

**Attention Foreign Exhibitors**

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted.

Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks.

To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds.

**Puppy Stake:** "A Puppy Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age and under 2 years of age on the day of the trial at which the Puppy Stake is judged." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations, Chapter 10, section 2*

**Limit Stake:** "A Limit Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs that have not placed in an Open All-Age Stake, or received 2 first placements in any Regular Official Stake (Puppy Stake excepted), at an approved trial in Canada or any equivalent Spaniel trial in any other country. Dogs must be at least 6 months of age on the day of the trial." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 3*

**Open All-Age Stake:** "An Open All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for all dogs at least six months of age on the day of the trial at which the stake is judged." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 4*

**Amateur All-Age:** "An Amateur All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for all dogs at least six months of age on the day of the trial at which the stake is judged. A person shall be considered an amateur if, he has not attempted to receive any part of his livelihood from the training, handling or showing of field trial or hunting dogs in the calendar year of the trial or the preceding calendar year. Dogs running an Amateur Stake must be owned by an amateur and handled by an amateur." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 6*

**Points:** Championship Points are awarded for placements in the All-Age Stakes, provided that there are 12 or more starters:

1st Place - 5 Points,      2nd Place - 3 Points,  
3rd Place - 2 Points,      4th Place - 1 Point

**Indignities:** "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, field trial marshal, volunteer, or competitor at a field trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations, Chapter 21, section 7.*

Puppy Stake Pigeons  
**Prizes:** Standard CKC rosettes to all placing dogs in each stake.

#### Notes:

*In accordance with The Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations an article of **BLAZE ORANGE** clearly visible above the waist, must be worn by all persons in the field. **NO** exceptions.*

*Special Rules Regulation 9.1.3 and Field Trial Champion Regulation 11.2.1, live full-winged game birds will be used.*

**Location** - The trial will now be held in the Mundare area. Directions to the grounds from Vegreville are, go 13km west on Highway 16 until you come to Range Road 172, turn north on RR172 and travel to TWP 534 for 3.5km. Watch for the signs.

Camping: Dry camping will be accommodated at the trial grounds on the quarter section, SE-27-53-17w4th on the north corner just off rr172.

Meals: A lunch concession will be available.

Running order and catalogues will be available Saturday at the trial grounds.

The Edmonton Spaniel Club is a member of the Canadian National Spaniel Field Trial Association.

All dogs earning points in this trial are eligible to enter the Canadian National Championship for the next two years.
