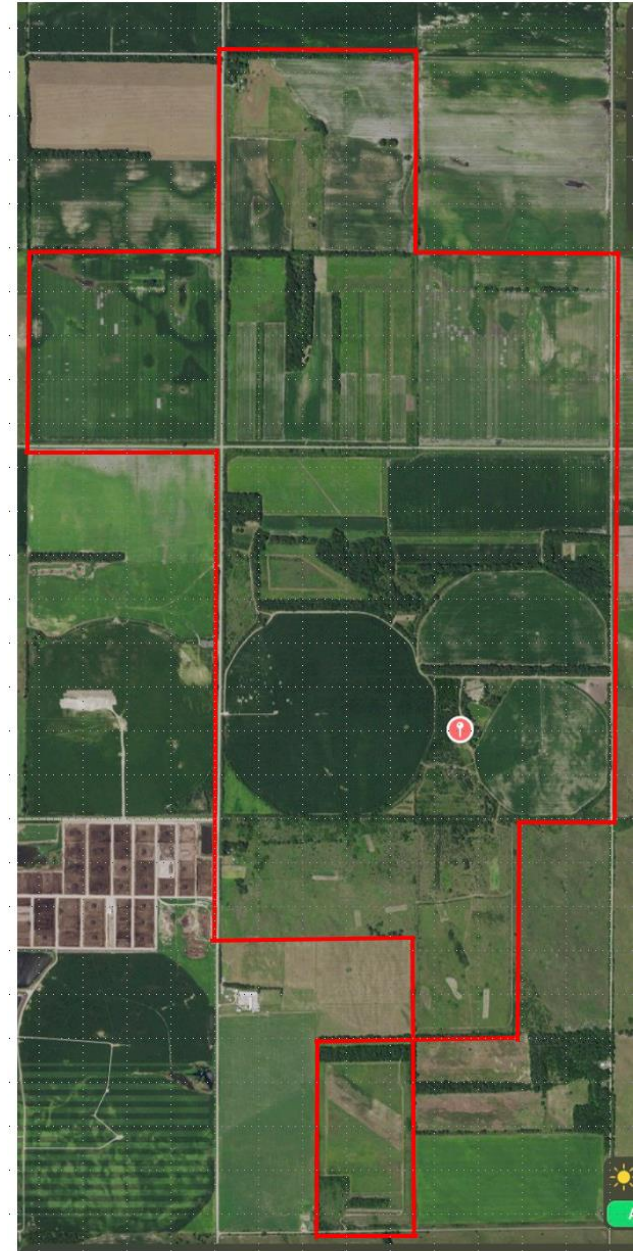
Multiple Hotels and RV Park Options
