ADDITIONAL EVENT INFORMATION

PLEASE NOTE: VEHICLE USE PERMIT REQUIRED

The Oregon Dept of Fish & Wildlife now requires a Vehicle Use Permit for Denman Wildlife Area. Permits can be purchased online, at an ODFW Office that sells licenses, or at a license sales agent. A daily permit is \$10, and an annual permit is \$30. Permits are transferrable between cars, but each car must have a permit displayed on the dash while parked at Denman Wildlife Area. SAFETY: All people in the field during land work and water work when live ammunition is being used must wear blaze orange. Smoking is not allowed while in the field. Smoking is permitted in the parking area.

A REMINDER: Please remember that training of dogs is not permitted on any part of the grounds on the day of a test. You are asked to keep your dog on leash or confined when not on the course being tested.
